To be considered for the Maple Federal Credit Union and Chapter scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a member of Maple Federal Credit Union
- Be graduating from high school in the spring of 2023, or currently enrolled in undergraduate studies at an accredited college, university, or technical school or with plans to attend an accredited college, university or technical school full-time in the fall of 2023
- Have maintained a 3.0 GPA based on 6 high school semesters or 1 most recent, completed college semester
- Have scored a 21 or higher on the ACT exam
- Complete an application and personal essay

Immediate family members of current Maple Federal Credit Union employees and Board of Directors **ARE NOT** eligible for the scholarship.

Application Package

All applicants must submit an application package which includes:

- A completed application
- A current high school transcript or college transcript
- A copy of his/her official ACT or SAT results
- A personal essay

- A photo of the applicant
- Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher from his/her junior or senior year (only applies to high school seniors), or current college professor or advisor

Selection

All qualified applications will be forwarded to the Maple FCU scholarship committee and the Lafayette Chapter scholarship committee. Only one application will be accepted from each participating member, regardless of membership at multiple participating credit unions. Final selection of the scholarship recipients will be made through a random drawing to be held at a regular Chapter meeting.

Award

Maple will award one \$2,000 scholarship to the outstanding scholar as chosen by the scholarship committee, plus three \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded from the remaining applicants by random draw. The Lafayette Chapter will also award three \$1,000 scholarships by random draw from all qualified applicants. The recipients can use the scholarship for any school related expenses. The recipients will receive the award payment in full in the form of a check. The check will be made payable directly to the recipients when proof of registration for the Fall Semester has been provided to the Scholarship Committee.

Notification

Maple Scholarship: Winner of the scholarship will be announced at the Annual Meeting.

Lafayette Chapter Scholarship: Each applicant will be notified by mail whether or not they have been chosen as one of the scholarship recipients. The Lafayette Chapter scholarship recipients will receive notification by **May 31, 2023**. The recipients can use the scholarship for any school related expenses. The recipients will receive the award payment in full in the form of a check. The check will be made payable directly to the recipients when proof of registration for the Fall 2023 Semester has been provided.
